Every issue of the Hackney-Norins Newsletter highlights an individual or a program in the Department - this issue highlights one of our newest faculty members, Dr. Elizabeth Bryant, Assistant Professor of Clinical Dermatology.

A native Hoosier, Elizabeth Weyerbacher's hometown is Boonville Indiana (near Evansville). Her father John is a lawyer, and mother Pauley a retired grocery store owner. She was always interested in medicine from grade school. After graduation from Evansville Memorial High,

she went to Indiana University in Bloomington then onto IU Medical School here in Indianapolis. Following her internship in the Yale system (St. Raphael's at New Haven, CT), Dr. Bryant was recruited to be the first IU Dermatology Clinical Trials Fellow with Drs. Stephen Wolverton and Lawrence Mark. She describes her time as a Fellow as "careeraltering" -"there was a steep learning curve to understand clinical trials, participating in all aspects from designing

and writing protocols to enrolling patients and analyzing data". Dr. Bryant attributes her faculty mentors and Study Coordinator Treana Porter with her success. She began her dermatology residency here and graduated June, 2013. Dr. Bryant was chosen by the faculty to receive the Francouer Award, which is presented annually to the "top" resident. Dr. Bryant decided upon a career in academia, and "this is the best place for me—we have

an excellent and well-rounded program in a very relaxed and supportive environment. In addition to being a well-rounded and good doctor and mother, I want to provide the type of mentorship that I received". Dr. Bryant is back working with Treana on building the

clinical trials unit. Her goal is to continue to expand the types of studies of cutting edge therapies available to patients here in Indiana. She sees patients at our Adult Outpatient Center and Springmill clinics as well as the Simon Cancer Center participating in IU's multidisciplinary Melanoma Clinic. Dr. Bryant also conducts several clinics per week at the V.A.
